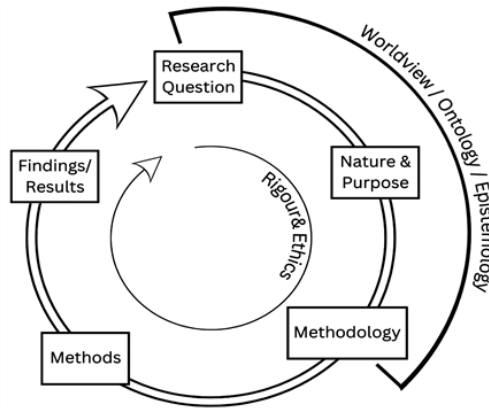


Figure 1: Figure title bold, Times New Roman 10
